

## **Job Title: Psychologist and Supervisor**

Hamm Clinic is seeking a full-time doctoral-level psychologist to provide psychotherapy and to participate in the training and supervision of psychology trainees.

### **Current Position:**

*Psychotherapy:* The psychologist will provide care for a caseload of psychotherapy patients, utilizing individual, couples, and/or family therapy modalities.

*Supervision and Training:* This position is a unique opportunity to assume a leadership role in psychology training, within an APA-accredited internship program. The psychologist will provide individual supervision for psychology trainees. In addition, the psychologist will participate in the Psychology Training Committee and teach select training activities for trainees and staff.

### **Primary Responsibilities specific to the Psychologist/Supervisor position:**

- Provide psychotherapy services to adults, from an individual, couples, and/or family modality.
- Provide supervision for psychology trainees (interns and post-doctoral fellows).
- Participate in Psychology Training Committee.
- Provide trainings or facilitate select training activities.
- Participate in multi-disciplinary team consultation meetings once per week.
- Effectively coordinate care across disciplines for the provision of quality services.
- Manage periodic on-call.

- Doctorate in counseling or clinical psychology from APA-accredited program.
- Licensed or license eligibility as a psychologist in the state of Minnesota.

#### **Knowledge, Skills, Abilities:**

- Strong psychotherapy skills to work with a range of presenting concerns.
- Experience with clinical supervision, in training or practice.
- Knowledge and sensitivity to multicultural issues.
- Knowledge of issues of a community mental health population.
- Strong interpersonal skills including strong oral, written, and listening communication abilities.

- Bi-lingual in English and Spanish
- Experience providing clinical services to a community mental health population.
- Presentation and training skills desired.

- Experience working with families and couples.
- Experience and skills in working with substance abuse.
