



**Job Title: Hamm Clinic Social Work Fellow
2021-2022**

Salary: \$37,500 plus individual benefits (medical and dental coverage, healthcare savings account, paid federal holidays, 3 weeks of paid time off, transportation stipend)

Hamm Clinic is seeking a full-time, two-year Social Work Fellow. Hamm Memorial Psychiatric Clinic is a private, nonprofit, Rule 29 community mental health center located in downtown Saint Paul. The clinic serves a diverse adult population with psychotherapy for individuals, couples, families, and groups. The clinic offers psychiatric care and assessment services in addition to psychotherapy.

Hamm Clinic's mission is to provide high quality, culturally responsive mental health care, with a focus on serving individuals unable to access or pay for services. We also offer expert training and education for mental health professionals, while leading the way toward more effective, evaluation-driven care throughout our community. Social Work Fellows will experience Hamm Clinic's innovative, integrated Model of Care as they participate in a well-rounded training program to advance clinical skills, and develop a robust professional identity. The placement is designed to meet the requirements for licensure as an LICSW in Minnesota. This position will be 100% remote until the COVID-19 pandemic abates.

Fellows must pass a criminal background check. Fellows have the option of working on either Monday or Tuesday evening until 8 pm to see clients. All trainees are required to be onsite (virtually during the pandemic) at Hamm from 8 am to 2 pm on Wednesdays. Fellows who are new to Hamm Clinic must attend Wednesday morning seminars during their first year. The fellowship will begin in summer/fall 2021 (exact date is negotiable).

Core Requirement:

Hamm Clinic is committed to an integrated model of mental health care with a focus on psychotherapy within a multi-disciplinary and collaborative community. Our goal is to do this work in a trauma-informed, anti-oppressive environment in which all identities are welcome and valued and in which employees strive to maintain an intersectional lens in considering their own privilege and how that might impact their work. It is expected that all are dedicated to learning and supporting this model, as appropriate for their specific duties.

Eligibility:

Applicants must meet the following prerequisites to be considered for the fellowship:

1. Completion of a clinical master of social work training program
2. Possession of an LGSW by the beginning of the training year

Primary Responsibilities:

- Provide psychotherapy to adult individuals, couples and families.
- Participate in multidisciplinary team case consultation.
- Participate in staff and trainee in-service trainings.
- Participate in Hamm Annual Conference.
- Participate in one of Hamm's committees: (Cultural Responsiveness Collective, Program Development and Policies Committee, Wellness & Sustainability Committee.)
- Identify, develop, and achieve specialized training goals.
- Participate in the Minnesota Institute for Contemporary Psychotherapy and Psychoanalysis (MICPP) program that provides training, education and research in contemporary psychoanalysis. Classes are held on Friday afternoons.

Core Training Opportunities:

- Individual Clinical Supervision
- Training Seminar and/or MICPP training
- Reflective Group Supervision
- Learn to use outcome measures such as the OQ-45 and Partners for Change Outcomes Measurement System (PCOMS)

Potential Training Opportunities:

- Program development
- Leadership development
- Group facilitation
- Case presentation
- Teaching and training
- Observation of Psychiatric Evaluation
- Opportunity for specialized consultations on trauma treatment, group therapy, and couples therapy
- Attend monthly Journal Club

Successful Completion:

- Complete 4,000 hours during the two social work fellowship years
- Participation in required training activities, and completion of goals outlined in the fellow's individualized training plan
